- Once every three months, class group delegates meet with the teachers, to evaluate positive aspects or aspects to improve



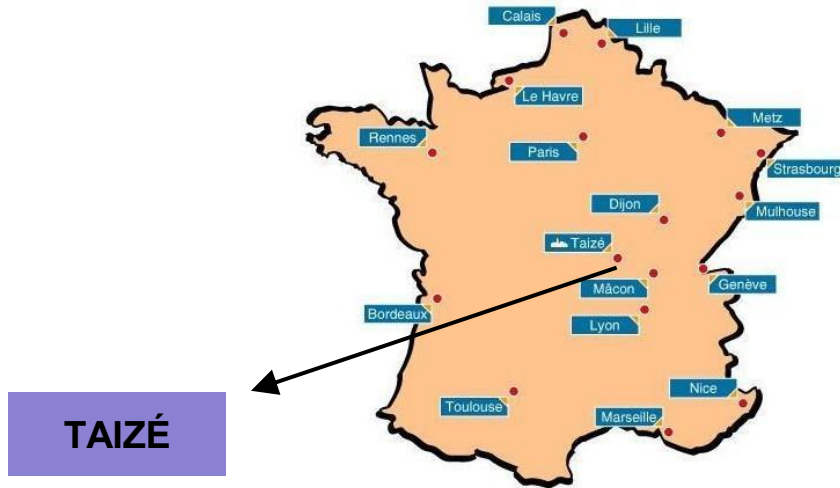
# Social action- Volunteering

- The main objective is to take a closer view of what's the real situation about immigration. How African people try to cross the borders for arriving to Europe in order to get a better life.

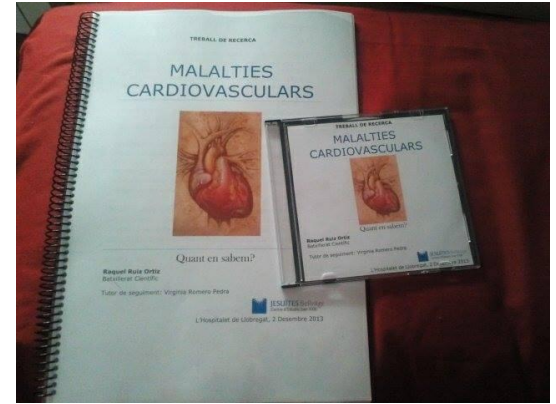

- The best ones can receive awards from the school and from some universities.



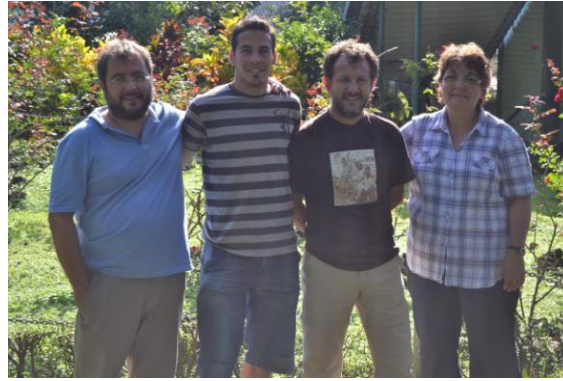
# Food Bank
